Who are we looking for?

We would like to invite people with an interest in or experience of arthritis pain, osteoarthritis, injury, sport and/or research, to work with us in one or more of several different ways:

- Giving us advice, ideas and opinions about research
- Reading and commenting on research proposals & grant applications
- Reviewing and commenting on documents and other activities associated with the research (for example information leaflets or web pages)
- Being a member of a lay advisory group or steering committee
- Helping us to give out any information about our research and the results to the people who need to know
- Attending meetings with other patient/public members, research staff and healthcare professionals

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Please note that if, for example, access to a computer or attending a meeting in person might be a problem for you, it would not rule you out of volunteering as there are many ways you could help. We can always try and support you to take part in the activities that interest you, even if you do not have any experience.
