Karl graduated from the University of Derby with first class honours in Applied Sport and Exercise Science BSc in 2018. He then moved to London to undertake an MSc in Human and Applied Physiology at King's College London, graduating in January 2020. Through his undergraduate and postgraduate degree, Karl gained experience conducting research in both elite sport environments and clinical settings. His MSc research project focussed on ankle muscle function during walking in children with cerebral palsy. Karl has started his PhD studentship at the University of Bath, investigating post-traumatic osteoarthritis, a type of osteoarthritis which develops after traumatic joint injury. His research at Bath will investigate the physiological and health outcomes after joint injury/surgery.

Karl's research interests include muscle function and morphology in clinical settings, sports injury, health outcomes after surgery, osteoarthritis and post-traumatic osteoarthritis.
