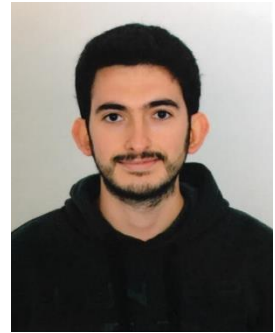


Ogulcan Caliskan BSc, MSc
