Lara Chapman is a podiatrist at Harrogate and District NHS Foundation Trust and a researcher at Leeds Institute of Rheumatic and Musculoskeletal Medicine, University of Leeds. Lara qualified as a podiatrist in 2016 and was awarded a graduate research internship with Versus Arthritis, which focussed on health literacy. Lara is commencing a 4-year HEE/NIHR Clinical Doctoral Research Fellowship in June 2022, which will involve developing a core outcome set for foot and ankle disorders in rheumatic and musculoskeletal diseases in collaboration with the international outcome measures in rheumatology initiative, OMERACT. Lara's clinical and research interests include foot and ankle outcome measures, inflammatory arthritis, health literacy, qualitative research and guideline development.

Lara is currently the fellow within the OMERACT Foot & Ankle Working Group, the early career research representative in the OARSI Foot & Ankle Research Discussion Group, and is leading the development of a new British Society for Rheumatology guideline for foot health in inflammatory arthritis.
